4 RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
5 IN SUPPORT OF THE STUDENT POLL WORKER PROGRAM

6 WHEREAS, in 1998 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside established the
7 Riverside County Youth Commission to advise the Board, to initiate support projects and to work with
8 people of all ages, and

9 WHEREAS, California Elections Code Section 12302 provides the qualifications for students to
10 serve as poll workers (requiring they be at least 16 years of age and a United States citizen at the time of
11 the election, and be a student in good standing with a grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale) in order
12 to provide youth an awareness of the election process, as well as the rights and responsibilities of voters,
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the Youth Commission, in partnership with the Registrar of Voters is seeking the
15 services of 400 students to participate in the "Student Poll Worker Program" in future elections, and

16 WHEREAS, on May 1, 2003, the Riverside County Youth Commission voted unanimously in
17 favor of the Student Poll Worker Program.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
19 Riverside, assembled in regular session on June 24, 2003, that this Board enthusiastically
20 lends its endorsement and support to the Riverside County Youth Commission efforts to develop and
21 participate in a Student Poll Worker Program within the County of Riverside.
