SUBJECT: Resolution 413-536 to Establish No-Parking Zones for Certain Commercial Vehicles, Sunnyslope area

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board adopt Resolution 413-536 to designate no-parking zones for certain commercial vehicles in the Sunnyslope area, and that the resolution be effective immediately.

BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Department received a number of requests from local residents from a neighborhood in the Sunnyslope area for prohibition of parking of large commercial vehicles including tractor-trailers.

Staff reviewed the area and determined that the roadways listed in Resolution No. 413-536 are residential in nature with narrow street widths and limited access, and are not suitable for the parking of large trucks.

It is recommended that truck parking prohibition be established for commercial vehicles having a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 pounds or more on the streets as indicated on the attached resolution and exhibit.

The residents of the affected neighborhood have provided a petition indicating residents/property owners of 25 out of a total of 36 residential lots, or 70%, support the parking prohibition of large commercial vehicles.

6 WHEREAS, a residential area within the Sunnyslope area of the County of
7 Riverside consists of narrow residential streets with limited access and is experiencing
8 continuous and unresolvable problems relating to the parking of commercial vehicles
9 therein; and,

11 WHEREAS, County Ordinance No. 413 prohibits the parking or standing
12 of certain commercial vehicles within a residential area designated by resolution of the
13 Board of Supervisors; and,

15 WHEREAS, the residents of the affected neighborhood have provided a
16 petition indicating 25 out of a total of 36 residential lots, or 70%, support the parking
17 prohibition of certain commercial vehicles within the residential area as shown on the
18 attached diagram; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
22 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
23 July 15, 2003, that the following parking restrictions are hereby established
24 in the Sunnyslope area, effective July 15, 2003:

1 No-Parking Zones for commercial vehicles having a manufacturer's gross vehicle
2 weight rating of 10,000 pounds or more at the following locations:

4 On Vernola Way, from Sierra Avenue to Laramore Lane;

5 On Laramore Lane, from Vernola Way to the easterly terminus;

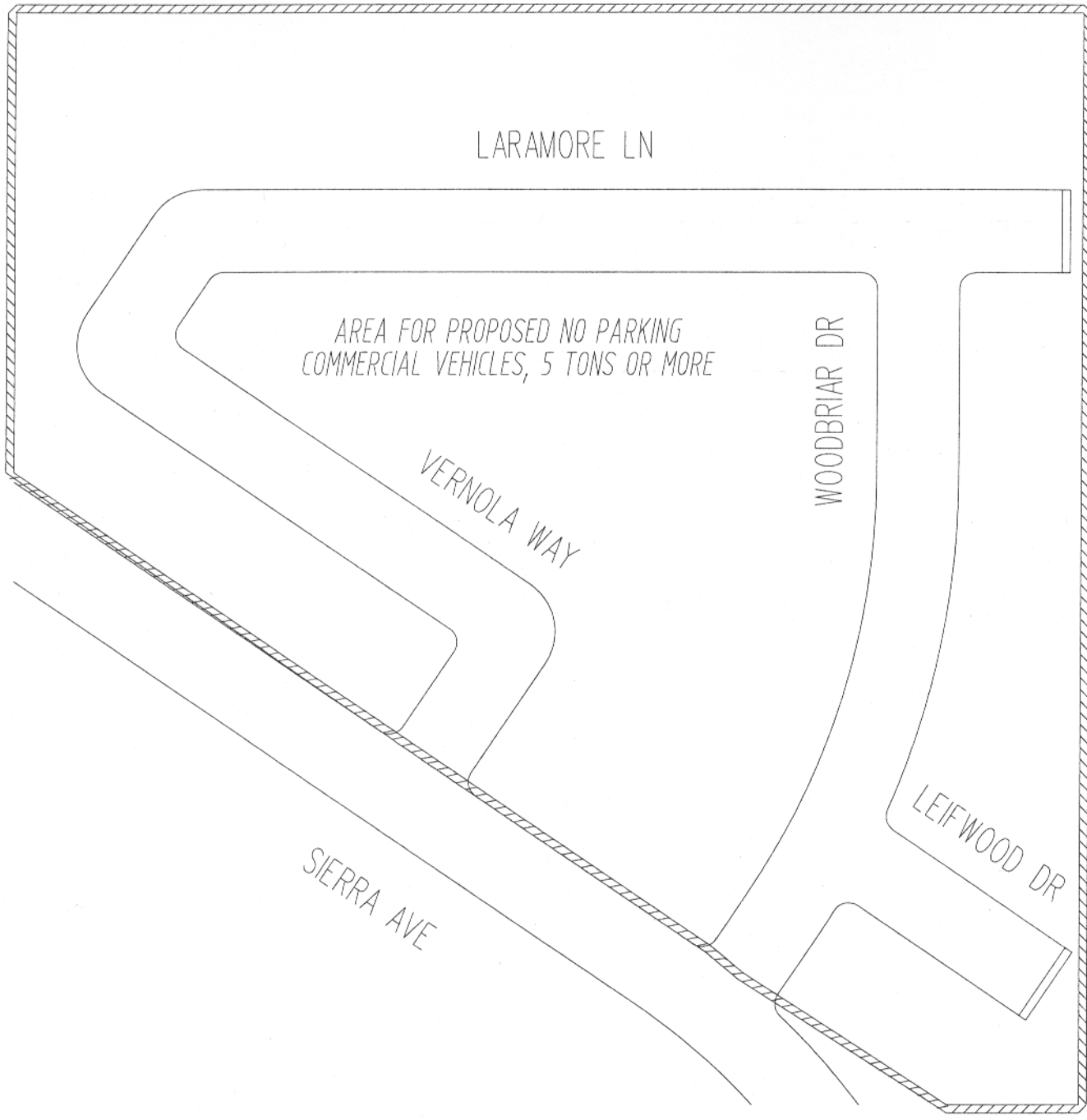
6 On Woodbriar Drive, from Laramore Lane to Sierra Avenue;

7 On Leifwood Drive, from Woodbriar Drive to the southeasterly terminus.

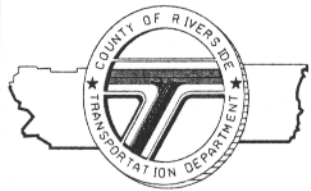
RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE
