SUBJECT: Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the Joint Powers Commission of the March Joint Powers Authority

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the law enforcement services Agreement with the Joint Powers Commission (JPC), on behalf of the March Joint Powers Authority, and authorize the Chairman to sign all copies.

BACKGROUND: On July 10, 2001 (3.53), the Board approved a law enforcement services Agreement between the County Sheriff's Department and the JPC for the period from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002. Under the Agreement, the Sheriff's Department provided four hours of daily police patrols in specified areas within the March Air Force Base.

In FY 2002-03, without the benefit of a formal Agreement, both parties continued this contractual relationship, and during the year, they met several times to discuss the patrol options that the Sheriff could implement at the March Air Force Base. Ultimately, the JPC decided to continue with the four hours of daily patrol and executed a five-year Agreement covering the period from July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2007. All service expenses will be fully recovered through Board-approved contract rates. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.
