**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve Resolution 2003-197, Authorizing Condemnation of Real Property for Freeway Improvement Purposes, on behalf of the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans), for the Interstate 215/91/60 Sequencing Project.

**BACKGROUND:** On May 20, 2003, the Board adopted the Resolution for the Notice of Intent to Condemn Real Property for Caltrans Parcel 18095 affected by this freeway improvement project. By authorizing condemnation of the above-referenced property, Caltrans will be able to begin the process to obtain possession, which will expedite the construction of the new interchange configuration. Negotiations are continuing with the property owners involved in this project.
