BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2003-249 adopted June 10, 2003, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for July 29, 2003, to receive testimony regarding the annexation of Zone 24 into Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Zone 24 will fund the maintenance and servicing of landscaping improvements within public right-of-ways located southerly of Temecula Creek Rd. easterly of Pacific Sunset Dr. and easterly and westerly of Horizon View St. southerly of Temecula Creek Rd. in the Temecula area and includes 120 single-family residential lots.

On June 11, 2003, a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2003-249 and an information sheet was mailed to all property owners within Zone 24 proposed for annexation into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2003-249 in The Press Enterprise at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of the Resolution no. 2003-249 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two other public locations within the County.

Section 53753 of the Government Code has been amended. It requires that the Board after conducting the public hearing designate and impartial person, having no vested interest in the outcome of the proposed annexation, to tally the ballots received by the close of the public hearing at a specified time, date and place.
