

SUBJECT: Disposal of Housing Authority Surplus Vehicles

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Commissioners 1) approve the disposal of Housing Authority property consisting of two pickup trucks formerly used by the maintenance department that have high mileage and one passenger vehicle that is inoperable 2) authorize the Executive Director or designee to execute all documents which effect the disposal of the vehicles.

JUSTIFICATION: The two pickups, a 1988 Ford F250 utility truck with 162,085 miles and a 1988 Ford F150 utility truck with 151,728 miles, have been used in maintenance work throughout the County. Both trucks are in need of substantial overhaul in order for them to be dependable. It is expected that the work required will exceed the value of the vehicles. The 1988 Ford Tempo has 103,424 miles and has an inoperable engine. The imminent sale of Housing Authority real property will also cause them to become surplus property. It is expected that each pickup will realize approximately \$1000 at public sale. The passenger vehicle is expected to bring scrap value only.
