AUTHORIZATION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT IN REAL PROPERTY
MURRIETA CREEK CHANNEL

BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session assembled on July 29, 2003, at least four-fifths of all members concurring, that the granting of easement interest by the District to City of Temecula, in real property known as Parcel 7020-509A & B, as described on Encroachment Exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager-Chief Engineer or his designee of the District is authorized to execute any other documents and administer all actions necessary to complete the transaction.
