SUBJECT: University Wash – Parcel 1120-101  
Authorization to Sell District Owned Excess Real Property

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

1. Approve Resolution No. F2003-37, Authorizing the Sale of Excess Land – University Wash, property consisting of a portion of Parcel 1120-101 by Deed with State of California; and authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code.
2. Authorize and direct the Clerk of the Board to certify acceptance of any documents running in favor of the District as part of this transaction.
3. Authorize the General Manager-Chief Engineer of the District or his designee to execute any other documents and administer all actions necessary to complete this transaction.

JUSTIFICATION:

A fee interest described as Parcel 1120-101 was originally granted to the District by the State of California in 1965 for flood control purposes. The State of California, Department of Transportation is planning the construction of State Route 60/91/215 Design Sequencing Interchange. The portion of the parcel, shown on Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is needed for this Interchange and an offer to purchase has been made by the State of California. It has been determined that this portion of the property is no longer required for flood control purposes and the Interchange construction will have no affect upon the water retention levels within the remainder portion of the property. All costs including escrow and/or title insurance shall be borne by the purchaser.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager-Chief Engineer or his designee of the District is authorized to execute any other documents and administer all actions necessary to complete the transaction.

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EXHIBIT "B"

That portion of Lot 62 of the East Riverside Land Company's Subdivision of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Meridian, in the City and County of Riverside, State of California, as per the map filed in Book 6, Page 44 of Maps, Records of San Bernardino County, State of California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the northerly line of said Lot 62 with the southwesterly line of the land conveyed to the Riverside County Flood Control District by document recorded November 18, 1965 as Instrument No. 131056, Official Records of said County; thence South 89°11'03" East 19.400 meters (63.65 feet) along said northerly line; thence South 03°29'37" West 18.476 meters (60.62 feet) to said southwesterly line; thence North 44°18'37" West 26.158 meters (85.82 feet) along said southwesterly line to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

This conveyance is made for the purpose of a freeway and the grantor hereby releases and relinquishes to the grantee any and all abutter's rights of access, appurtenant to grantor's remaining property, in and to said freeway.

The bearings and distances used in the above description are based on the California Coordinate System of 1983, Zone 6. Multiply all distances shown by 1.00002215 to obtain ground level distances.
