SUBJECT: Approval of Contract with Inland Valley Medical Center for the Provision of Level III Trauma Center Services in the Southwest Region of the County.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the contract for Trauma Services with Inland Valley Medical Center from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2007 with the option of two (2), two year extensions;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to execute said contract; and,
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to file one original and return three (3) executed documents to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administration for processing.

BACKGROUND: The revised Riverside County EMS Agency Trauma Plan was approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 28, 2001 and by the State EMS Authority on October 25, 2002. Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations, Division 9, Section 100255(g) requires that there be written agreements between the local EMS agency and the individual trauma centers.

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Background (continued)

On September 21, 2001 Inland Valley Medical Center was surveyed by an independent team of surveyors, and was re-verified by the EMS Agency as a Level II Trauma Center.

Inland Valley Medical Center has been an active member of the Trauma system. Inland Valley has met all responsibilities and has been an asset to the trauma system in Riverside County.

This contract will be for the time period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2007 with the option of two (2) two year extensions.
