SUBJECT: Approval of Contract with Tenet Health System, Inc., d.b.a. Desert Regional Medical Center for the Provision of Level II Trauma Center Services in the Coachella Valley located in the Eastern portion of the County.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the contract for Trauma Services with Desert Regional Medical Center from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2007 with the option of two (2), two year extensions;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to execute said contract; and,
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to file one original and return three (3) executed documents to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administration for processing.

BACKGROUND: The revised Riverside County EMS Agency Trauma Plan was approved by the Board of Supervisors approved on August 28, 2001 and by the State EMS Authority on October 25, 2002. Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations, Division 9, Section 100255(g) requires that there be written agreements between the local EMS agency and the individual trauma centers.
