SUBJECT: Approval of the Third Amendment to the Agreement No. DPH02K.080 between Valley Health Systems and Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health

BACKGROUND: Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is collaborating with Valley Health System on the ongoing project, Healthy Children's Connection, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. Valley Health System offers services to clients in Supervisorial Districts 1, 3 and 5 with funding through the Riverside County First Five Commission in the amount of \$294,819.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level.
