SUBJECT: Ratify the Third Amendment to the Agreement #DPH01K.141 with Ujima

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Third Amendment between Ujima and the County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health, to extend the performance period of March 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003 and to increase the amount by \$25,801; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson of the Board to execute (4) originals of said Amendment; and
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to file one (1) executed amendment and return three (3) executed originals of said Amendment to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administration for final processing.

BACKGROUND: The Ryan White CARE Act was enacted in 1990 to provide federal funding for comprehensive health and social services for persons who are living with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). The Federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) provides funding through Title I of the Ryan White CARE Act to geographic areas disproportionately affected by the HIV epidemic. Ujima was selected through a Request For Proposal (RFP) process and is a progressive Social and Economic Development Non-Profit agency serving Riverside and San Bernardino County. This agreement provides outreach encounters by one-on-one contact, group settings and/or events to encourage individuals to learn his/her HIV status and if infected seek medical care. The previous agreement and amendments were not over \$25,000.
