6 BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of  
7 Supervisors of Riverside County, State of California, in regular session assembled on  
8 August 19, 2003, and NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN as follows:

9 1. That this Board will consider passing a resolution of necessity  
10 authorizing the condemnation of certain parcels of real property for freeway  
11 improvement purposes described as portions of Assessor's Parcel Number 210-110-  
12 009, also known as Caltrans Parcel #17768, shown as legal descriptions and plat maps  
13 on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board, and located in Riverside, and to hold a  
14 public hearing on September 9, 2003, at 10:00 a.m. in the meeting room of the Board of  
15 Supervisors located on the 1st Floor, County Administrative Center Annex, 4080 Lemon  
16 Street, Riverside, California, at which time the person or entity whose real property is  
17 sought to be condemned and whose name and address appears on the last equalized  
18 County Assessment Roll and who has filed a timely written request to appear and be  
19 heard, will be given an opportunity to be heard on the following matters:

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22 a. Whether the public interest and necessity require the  
23 construction of the public improvement.

24 b. Whether the public improvement is planned and located in  
25 the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least  
26 private injury.

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c. Whether the real property sought to be acquired is necessary for the construction of the public improvement.



That the failure of any person, whose real property is sought to be condemned, to file a written request to appear and be heard with the Clerk of the Board within 15 days after a copy of the resolution is mailed to, or personally served upon such person, will result in his or her waiver of the right to appear and be heard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of California, Department of Transportation, has caused a letter of intent, see attached, and a copy of the right of way map to be mailed to or personally served upon each person or entity whose real property is sought to be condemned and whose name and address appears on the last equalized County Assessment Roll.
