BACKGROUND: The U.S. Department of the Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs, South California Agency has requested this Agreement to provide a method of reimbursement for wildland fire suppression costs incurred on Indian Trust Lands within the jurisdiction of the Riverside County Fire Department. Revenue from this contract will only occur if there is a qualifying fire event, therefore no budget adjustment is required at this time.

The term of this agreement will be through December 31, 2007.
