RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- (1) assess the reasonable costs of abatement of a public nuisance (substandard Travel Trailer) in the above-referenced matter to be five thousand, three hundred, sixty-seven dollars and thirty-five cents (US \$5,367.35);
- (2) assess the costs of abatement against the above-described subject property;
- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien; and
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment.

BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15) and 725 (RCC Title 1) and Section 1724, Article 10, Title 25 of the California Code of Regulations, provide authority for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

On March 27, 2002, the Department of Building and Safety issued a Ten-Day Notice to Abate a substandard mobile home on the subject property, which was deemed to be an imminent hazard. On or about April 16, 2003, a substandard travel trailer located on the subject property was removed under direction of the Riverside County Department of Building and Safety pursuant to a seizure warrant.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 1996.

All notices regarding the Statement of Expense hearing have been given to Luis A. Ruiz, the property owner, as required by law (see attached exhibits).
