

SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 413.29 ("Parking")

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors introduce and adopt the above-referenced ordinance on successive weeks.

BACKGROUND: The Fifth District Trash Task Force has been reviewing issues of concern with regard to illegal trash dumping on public and private property as well as related aspects of visual blight that negatively impact community aesthetics and property values. A portion of such review has covered the problems presented to law enforcement agencies by abandoned or unattended vehicles left on a County highway. The attached ordinance incorporates changes requested by the Trash Task Force to the provisions of Ordinance No. 413 that address its concerns regarding vehicles that are left standing or parked on a County highway. The attached ordinance incorporates the requested changes. Specifically, the ordinance amendment:

1. Lowers the existing restriction on parking or standing of vehicles on any County highway from five (5) days down to three (3) days as provided in California Vehicle Code § 22651(k).
2. Provides for minor clarifications of a grammatical and editorial nature.


