**SUBJECT:** Cooperative Agreement for the landscaping of State Route 60 interchanges.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board approve and execute the attached Cooperative Agreement for the design, construction and maintenance of the landscape beautification of five (5) interchanges along State Route 60 east of Interstate 15.

**BACKGROUND:** On November 19, 1999, the Redevelopment Agency and the Transportation Department submitted a joint application to the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) for funding from the Federal Transportation Enhancement Activities Program for the Jurupa Valley Interchange Landscaping and Beautification Project. On January 12, 2002, the RCTC approved the project for funding in the amount of \$1,595,000 for construction. The Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside is contributing \$5,000,000 in redevelopment funds for design and construction of the project. The project includes landscape beautification to five (5) freeway interchanges along State Route 60 east of Interstate 15: (1) Van Buren Boulevard – Mission Boulevard, (2) Etiwanda Avenue, (3) Country Village Road – Mission Boulevard, (4) Pedley Road and (5) Pyrite Road.

Form 11 - Cooperative Agreement for the landscaping of State Route 60 interchanges.  
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**BACKGROUND (Continued):** The cooperative agreement between State of California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) and County of Riverside (County) specifically requires the County to construct the improvements in accordance with CalTrans specifications and maintain the improvements for six years. After the County completes the six years of maintenance, the cooperative agreement requires CalTrans to be responsible for the ongoing maintenance of the improvements.

In order to obtain final design approval from CalTrans, the County must execute the attached CalTrans cooperative agreement, which outlines each party's responsibility throughout the course of construction and maintenance for the project.

Agency staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve the attached cooperative agreement between CalTrans and the County.
