SUBJECT: Ratify the Renewal Agreement, with Sodexho America, LLC FY 2003/04, for nutrition contracts.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Sodexho America, LLC.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: The agreement with Sodexho America, LLC covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the amount of \$1,271,077 continues the provision of meals program to the seniors of Corona, Norco, Glen Valley, Home Gardens, Lake Elsinore, Riverside, Woodcrest, Rubidoux, Perris, Murrieta, Temecula, Cathedral City, Desert Hot Springs, Coachella, Indio, and Thermal. These Riverside County seniors are eligible to participate in either the Congregate Meals Program or the Home Delivered Meal Program.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

Both programs consist of the procurement, preparation, and serving/delivery of meals, as well as nutritional education and counseling.

Renewing the agreement with Sodexho America, LLC would prevent any interruption of the services so vitally needed by this population.

The services outlined in this agreement are funded through the Older Americans Act, Title III C1 and C2, Congregate and Home Delivered Meals, and support the goals and objectives of the Office on Aging's four year Strategic Plan, approved by both the Office on Aging Advisory Council and the Board of Supervisors.
