Departmental Concurrence

BACKGROUND: The agreement with Care Connexus Inc. covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the reimbursable amount of \$70,680 continues the Adult Day Care Program to Riverside County seniors of the First, Second and Fifth Districts. Other Districts are covered by other contracts.

The Adult Day Care Program Allows Riverside County seniors to maintain optimal capacity for self-care and continue to live in the community, rather than placed in a long-term care institution.

BACKGROUND: (continued)
