SUBJECT: Ratify the Renewal Agreement, with Family Service Association of Western Riverside County FY 2003/04 for Adult Day Care.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Family Service Association of Western Riverside County.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: The agreement with Family Service Association of Western Riverside County covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the reimbursable amount of \$30,000 continues the Adult Day Care Programs to Riverside County seniors of the First, Second, Third, and Fifth Districts. The Fourth Districts is covered by other contracts.

The Adult Day Care Program Allows Riverside County seniors to maintain optimal capacity for self-care and continue to live in the community, rather than placed in a long-term care institution.

BACKGROUND: (continued)
