**BACKGROUND:** (continued)

The Office of County Counsel has approved this agreement as to form.

The Community Education/Advocacy Program consist of providing disease prevention and health promotion services, and information at multipurpose senior centers, congregate meal sites and through home-delivered meals programs, to educate seniors, their families, friends, and the community, on rights, benefits, and entitlements

Renewing the current agreement with Partnership to Preserve Independent Living for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities would prevent any interruption of the services so vitally needed by this population.

Funding of services in this agreement are provided by the Older Americans Act, Title III D, Preventive Health, and support the goals and objectives of the Office on Aging's four-year Strategic Plan, approved by both the Office on Aging Advisory Council and the Board of Supervisors. The late request, for Board of Supervisors approval, is due to delays in State Budget and the submission of complete contractor documentation.

No additional County funds are being requested for this agreement.
