**BACKGROUND:** The agreement with Volunteer Center of Riverside County covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the reimbursable amount of \$254,949 continues the Ombudsman Program to seniors in Riverside County.

The Ombudsman Program consists of activities on behalf of residents of long-term care facilities; effectively assert civil and human rights, ensuring the rights and entitlement of seniors by investigating and resolving complaints, and initiating corrective action where necessary.
