Community Services and Senior Center Support maintains or improves the well being of older persons through the provision of necessary services in the community and the support of seniors.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

The Office of the County Counsel has approved this agreement as to form.

Renewing the current agreement with Colorado River Senior/Community Center would prevent any interruption of the services so vitally needed by this population.

Funding of services in this agreement are provided by the Older Americans Act, Title III B, and Supportive Services and support the goals and objectives of the Office on Aging's four-year Strategic Plan, approved by both the Office on Aging Advisory Council and the Board of Supervisors.
