SUBJECT: Cooperative Reimbursement Agreement Between the Riverside County Fire Department, City of Moreno Valley and the City of Perris.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached Cooperative Agreement between the Riverside County Fire Department, City of Moreno Valley and the City of Perris and authorize the Chairman to sign the agreement on the Board's behalf.

BACKGROUND: The City of Moreno Valley and the City of Perris requested an agreement with the County of Riverside to clarify the roles and responsibilities and provide a method of reimbursement for a cost sharing of three Fire Captains at the College Park Fire Station #91 located in Moreno Valley.

Due to College Park Fire Station's strategic southeast location, we have determined by augmenting staff at this location we can provide a faster response to the north end of the City of Perris in addition to providing aerial ladder truck response to the adjoining unincorporated areas. Neither the City of Perris nor the Riverside County Fire Department has an aerial ladder truck available for immediate emergency response in this area. We believe this agreement is mutually beneficial to all parties and enhances our fire protective services in this region. (Continued on Page 2)


