**BACKGROUND (Cont.):**

for students to gain needed fieldwork experience, and gives DPSS the opportunity to acclimate students to the public sector with the hope that when students gain their degree, they will be assimilated into the DPSS environment and fill hard-to-recruit positions.

These Student Interns are thoroughly screened including LiveScan for background checks, drug testing, and undergoing physicals. Each Student Intern has a mentor social worker who provides hands-on supervision for them by observation and interaction. Any legal documents produced by the Student Intern require supervisor approval.

As DPSS and CSULB have an existing relationship for this program, this Agreement, which Risk Management has reviewed and approved, would formalize that relationship.
