Patrol and investigation duties for Diamond Valley Lake are the responsibility of the Sheriff's Department, and are handled by the Hemet Station. MWD has requested a dedicated Sheriff's Sergeant to oversee law enforcement boat patrols for the lake and new recreational area beginning September 10, 2003, and has entered into an agreement with the Sheriff for that level of service. MWD will supply Sheriff's personnel with a boat and will be responsible for all associated expenses. All other expenses associated with this Agreement will be recovered through Board-approved contract rates. County Counsel has approved the agreement as to form.


