SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR FREEWAY IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES-STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - INTERSTATE 215/91/60 SEQUENCING PROJECT

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve Resolution 2003-400, Authorizing Condemnation of Real Property for Freeway Improvement Purposes, on behalf of the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans), for the Interstate 215/91/60 Sequencing Project.

BACKGROUND: On August 19, 2003, the Board adopted the Resolution for the Notice of Intent to Condemn Real Property for Caltrans Parcel 17768 affected by this freeway improvement project. By authorizing condemnation of the above-referenced property, Caltrans will be able to begin the process to obtain possession, which will expedite the construction of the new interchange configuration. Negotiations are continuing with the property owners involved in this project.

4 AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION OF REAL PROPERTY
5 FOR I-215/60/91 FREEWAY IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES

6 BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of
7 Supervisors of Riverside County, State of California, in regular session assembled on
8 September 9, 2003, as follows:

9
10 1. That notice of intention to adopt this resolution was given to each
11 person, whose hereinafter described real property is to be acquired by eminent domain,
12 in accordance with Section 1245.235 of the Code of Civil Procedure and a hearing was
13 conducted by the Board of the matters contained herein.

14 2. That the authority for the County to acquire the real property by
15 eminent domain is contained in Article 1, Section 19 of the California Constitution;
16 Sections 760 and 102 of the Streets and Highways Code; Section 25350.5 of the
17 Government Code; Sections 1240.010, 1240.020, 1240.030, 1240.110, 1240.420 and
18 1263.270 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

20 3. That the public interest and necessity require the proposed project.

21 4. That the use for which the real property is to be taken is for the
22 Interstate 215/91/60 Sequencing Project, for road improvement purposes, including
23 construction and maintenance, and for other uses incidental thereto and required.

25 5. That the real property sought to be condemned is necessary for the
26 construction of the public improvement and is located adjacent to Interstate 215, State
27 Route 91 and State Route 60 in the County of Riverside, State of California, generally
28 described as Assessor's Parcel Number 210-110-009, also known as Caltrans Parcel

1 #17768, and a specific description of the real property and the interests sought to be
2 condemned are set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference made a
3 part hereof.

5 6. That the public improvement is planned and located in the manner
6 that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

7
8 7. That the offer required by Section 7267.2 of the Government Code
8 has been made to the owner or owners of record.

9
10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of California, Department of
11 Transportation, after approval of the Authorization of Condemnation by the County of
12 Riverside Board of Supervisors, will continue with the processes necessary to acquire,
13 in the name of the State of California, fee simple title and temporary construction
14 easements in accordance with the Constitution and laws relating to eminent domain.
