BACKGROUND:

Departmental Concurrence

Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) wishes to construct a regional park facility in the Eastvale area of Riverside County. A portion of the proposed park is to be constructed within the District's Eastvale Master Drainage Plan Cleveland Avenue Detention Basin. The license agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which JCSD may construct and operate the portion of the park improvements located within the District's right of way.
