RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Adopt Resolution No. F2003-55 authorizing judicial foreclosure proceedings to be commenced against those parcels of real property within Improvement District No. 4-2 of Zone Four (San Jacinto River) for which assessments levied to pay the principal and interest on assessment bonds are delinquent.

BACKGROUND:

The Board's previous adoption of Resolution No. F88-13 authorized the issuance and sale of bonds to finance the construction of certain improvements within Improvement District No. 4-2 of Zone Four (San Jacinto River), and also covenanted the District to commence judicial proceedings within 150 days of the original delinquency date in the event bond assessments become delinquent and remain unpaid, and diligently prosecute these proceedings in an effort to enforce collection of the amounts due. Resolution No. F2003-55 is in keeping with the District's covenant made to the bondholders.

9 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation
10 District, by Resolution No. F88-13, authorized the issuance and sale of bonds to finance the
11 construction of certain improvements within Improvement District No. 4-2 of Zone 4 (San
12 Jacinto River) of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District; and

13 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District
14 by the terms of the aforementioned resolution, covenanted to timely initiate foreclosure
15 proceedings against those parcels of real property within the Improvement District that are
16 delinquent as to the assessment installments which were levied to pay the principal and interest
17 on said bonds.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND
19 ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water
20 Conservation District, acting in its capacity as the governing body of Improvement District No.
21 4-2 of Zone 4 (San Jacinto River) in regular session assembled on September 9, 2003, that:

22 Section 1. The parcels within Improvement District No. 4-2 listed on Exhibit
23 "A" attached hereto are delinquent for the amount as shown as of the date shown.

24 Section 2. The Auditor-Controller, in cooperation with the administrator of the
25 Improvement District and the special counsel designated in Section 3. below, is to:

- 26 a) Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 8833, cause the
27 Treasurer-Tax Collector to be credited upon the current tax roll with
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the amounts charged on account of the assessment installments to be
sued upon and to be relieved of further duty in regard thereto; and

- b) Request that the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County cause all
inquires regarding payment of the delinquent assessment installments
be forwarded to the special counsel.

Section 3. Sherman & Feller, A Law Corporation, as special counsel, is directed
to bring an action in Superior Court to foreclose against the enumerated parcels for the amounts
listed in Exhibit "A".
