SUBJECT: Approval of the Contract with the California State Emergency Medical Services Authority for the Disaster Medical Assistance Team (DMAT) Training Exercise 2003.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the contract with the California State Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) and the County of Riverside Community Health Agency Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in the amount of \$34,050 for the performance period of September 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003;
- 2) In accordance with Ordinance 459.4, direct the Purchasing Agent to subcontract with the California Disaster Medical Assistance Team (DMAT) CA-6 in the amount of \$22,100 for disaster medical equipment and supplies as specified in the State grant;
- 3) Authorize the Chairperson to sign eight (8) original copies of the contract on behalf of the County; and
- 4) Direct the Clerk of the Board to return all eight (8) signed copies of the contract to the CHA Contracts Administrator for final processing.

SUBJECT: Approval of the contract with the California State Emergency Medical Services Authority for the Disaster Medical Assistance Team Training Exercise 2003.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County EMS Agency has been awarded grant funding in the amount of \$34,050 from the California State Emergency Medical Services Authority for coordinating and participating in the Disaster Medical Assistance Team (DMAT) Training Exercise 2003. This annual training exercise will bring California's six DMATs together with California's EMSA and Riverside County's EMS Agency and local emergency medical responders in a jointly coordinated and managed exercise.

The 2003 Exercise is scheduled to take place from October 22, 2003 through October 26, 2003 at March Air Reserve Base in Riverside County. The training is designed for participants to experience first hand the events generated by long distance deployment, the tasks associated with multi-team-set-up operations and offer the opportunity for local and state responders to practice procedures used to successfully integrate state and local response systems. Basic training modules will be offered to participants, including: safety procedures, equipment and supplies off-loading, shelter assembly, field hospital set up, patient processing and site dismantlement.

As part of this grant the Community Health Agency will subcontract with California Disaster Medical Assistance Team (DMAT) CA-6 for the purchase of equipment and supplies required for the DMAT Training Exercise 2003.

This contract was received by CHA on August 29, 2003.
