**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Renewal Agreement, with Eisenhower Medical Center FY 2003/04 for Adult Day Care services in Districts 4 & 5.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Eisenhower Medical Center.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

**BACKGROUND:** The agreement with Eisenhower Medical Center covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the reimbursable amount of \$ 42,363 continues the Adult Day Care to Riverside County seniors of the Fourth and Fifth Districts.

The Adult Day Care Program Allows Riverside County seniors to maintain optimal capacity for self-care and continue to live in the community, not in a long term care institution.

**BACKGROUND:** (continued)
