SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PROGRAM AGREEMENTS AND RESOLUTION NUMBERS
2003- 483 , 2003- 484 and 2003- 485 .

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the agreements and attached resolutions for the:
 - a. Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction ("Urban Grant") Program award received from the California Department of Insurance
 - b. The Spousal Abuser Prosecution ("SAP") Grant Program award received from the California Department of Justice
 - c. Joint Power Agreement receiving reimbursement from the California Victim Compensation & Government Claims Board
2. Authorize the District Attorney to sign the standard agreements on behalf of the Board

BACKGROUND: The Urban Grant, SAP Grant and the Joint Power Agreement (as described in Attachment "A") are ongoing programs requiring Board Resolutions for the District Attorney to receive funding. Each resolution is effective for a three- year period beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2006. The resolutions have been reviewed and approved as form by County Counsel. Any necessary budget adjustments will be reflected cumulatively in the first quarter budget update.

California Department of Insurance (DOI): The Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction (“Urban Grant”) Program administered through the DOI is an ongoing program designed to investigate and prosecute organized automobile insurance fraud activity. Pursuant to the provisions of California Insurance Code Sections 1874.8 and 1874.81, the DOI has awarded the Riverside County District Attorney \$185,000 per funding cycle. The grant award is for three funding cycles starting July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2006.

California Department of Justice (DOJ): The Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program administered through the DOJ is an ongoing program designed to investigate and vertically prosecute domestic violence crimes with the hope to stop the cycle of violence at an early stage for the mental health and emotion of children and victimized partners. From July 2002 through June 2003, the Domestic Violence Unit reviewed 2,886 complaints involving domestic violence incidents occurring in western Riverside County. Six-experienced Deputy District Attorneys have been dedicated to the program. For the grant period from July 2003 through June 2004, program costs are anticipated to be \$118,791; \$95,033 available from DOJ and the 20% required County matching funds of \$23,758 are included in the department’s budget.

California Victim Compensation & Government Claims Board: Through a “Joint Power” agreement, the California Victim Compensation & Government Claims Board agreed to fund up to \$714,405 for the July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 period. The program is designed to assist victims and witnesses of crime with applying for state reimbursement for financial losses incurred as result of going through the court system.

9 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated Organized
10 Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction (“Urban Grant”) Program to be funded in part from funds made
11 available through and administered by the California Department of Insurance; Now, Therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,
13 State of California, in regular session assembled on October 7, 2003, that the District
14 Attorney of the County of Riverside, State of California is authorized, on its behalf, to submit the attached
15 proposal to the California Department of Insurance and is authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the
16 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside the Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions
17 or amendments thereof.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period
19 beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2006.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
21 expenditures controlled by this body.
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
