BACKGROUND:

The Jurupa Unified School District is constructing a new high school that also requires the construction of certain flood control and street improvements. The Agreement is necessary to formalize the provisions by which the referenced flood control project will be designed, funded, constructed, inspected, operated and maintained. Upon completion of the construction of the referenced project, the District will assume operation and maintenance responsibilities for the major storm drain facility. Transportation will assume the operation and maintenance responsibilities of all inlets, catch basins, laterals and connector pipes located within County rights of way. Jurupa Unified School District will assume the operation and maintenance responsibilities of all inlets and connector pipes located on the school's property.

This item will also appear on the County's agenda next week. County Counsel has approved this agreement as to legal form.

FINANCIAL:

The District is funding 50% of the storm drain construction costs for those portions of the storm drain located within the high school campus and 100% of the storm drain construction costs for the remainder of the flood control project. The District will incur future operation and maintenance costs associated with the major storm drain facility. Funds for this project are included in the District's Zone 1 budget for FY 2003-2004.

The proposed project site is located within the unincorporated Glen Avon area of Riverside County. The proposed project area is generally bounded by State Route 60 on the north, Jurupa Road on the south, Pyrite Street on the west, and Camino Real on the east. The project is specifically located in the western half of the southwest quarter of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, as shown on the U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute, "Fontana, California" Quadrangle.

Project Description:


The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) will enter into a cooperative agreement with the Jurupa Unified School District (JUSD) to construct the Jurupa-Pyrite MDP Line C Storm Drain. The Riverside County Planning Department has the land use authority and has approved the associated development (JUSD High School No. 3). JUSD is the lead agency for the construction of the storm drain and its associated development. The District is a CEQA responsible agency and will be funding a portion of the construction of the storm drain. Upon completion, the District will assume ownership and responsibility for the continued operation and maintenance of the storm drain.

This is to advise that the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District has approved the above described project on October, 2003 and has made the following determination regarding the above described projects:
