SUBJECT: Construction of traffic signal, lighting and associated improvements, State Route 79 (North) at Winchester Creek Avenue / Willows Avenue, Temecula area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board accept the low bid of R&M Electrical Contracting of Lake Forest, CA in the amount of \$176,876.00. Award the contract to that firm and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.

BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated August 19, 2003 (agenda item 3.58) the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of traffic signal, highway lighting and associated improvements at the intersection of State Route 79 (North) and Winchester Creek Avenue / Willows Avenue in the Temecula area of Riverside County. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 pm, Wednesday, September 10, 2003. Five bids were received. The lowest and best bid was submitted by R&M Electrical Contracting in the amount of \$176,876.00. The bid is \$49,674.00 (21.93%) less than the Engineer's Estimate. The contractor is qualified. The project is within the established budget, as shown on Attachment "A". The City of Temecula is scheduled to consider a cooperative agreement in October for providing funding for 25% of the project's costs. Annual traffic signal operating costs are estimated at \$1,500 for the County's funding share (25%), to be funded from gas tax. The City of Temecula will fund 25% and Caltrans will fund 50% of the operating costs. Project no. B3-0657.

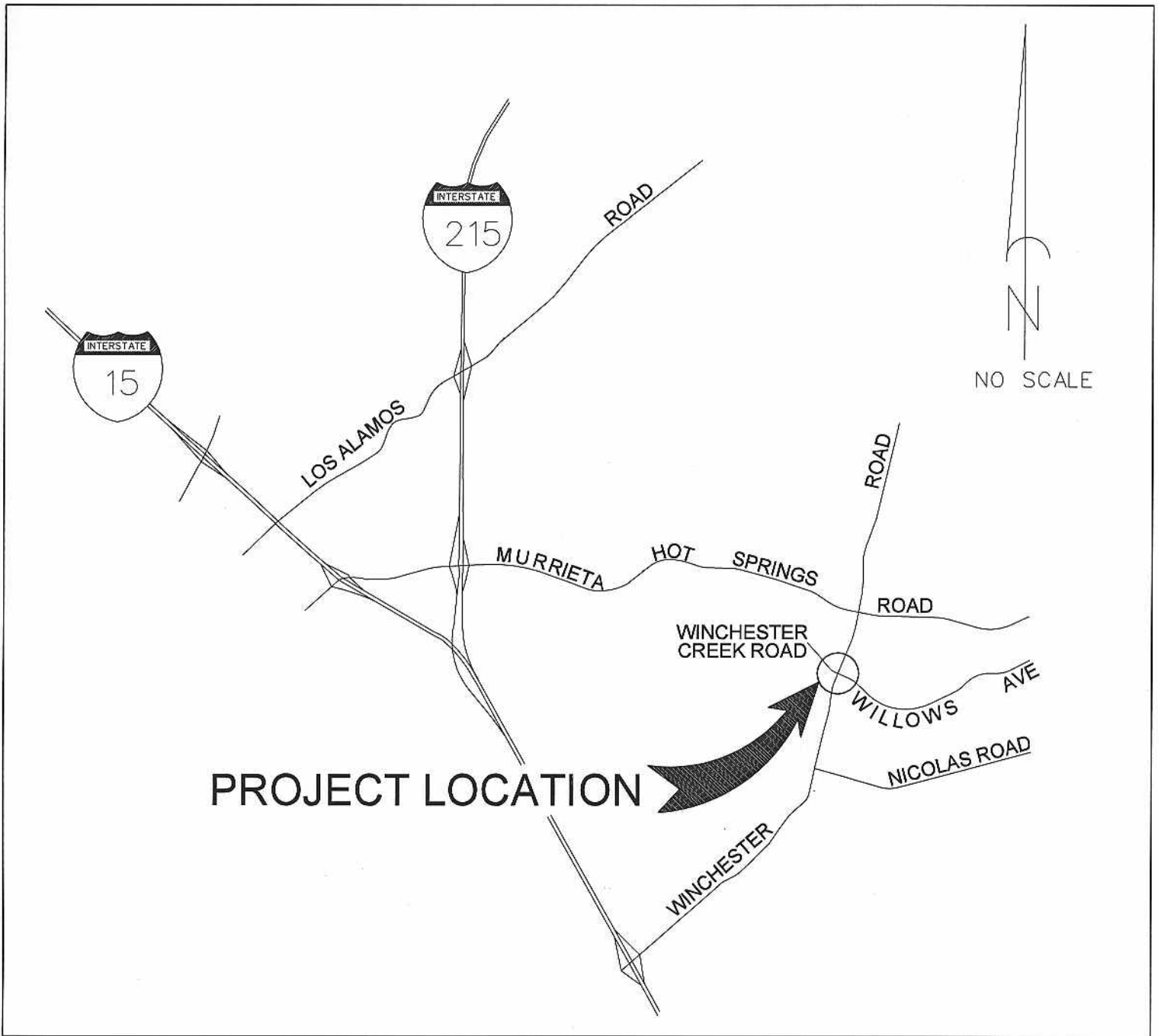
