SUBJECT: Urgency Measure for the Reche Canyon and Lake Skinner/Sage Areas

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board authorize the Director of Building and Safety to waive building permit fees and all related impact fees associated with the rebuilding of homes and other auxiliary buildings destroyed by the recent fire in the Reche Canyon and Lake Skinner/Sage areas.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Building and Safety has been advised by the Riverside County Fire Department that the recent fire in the Reche Canyon and Lake Skinner/Sage areas resulted in the destruction of dwellings and auxiliary buildings as well as damage to other structures. The intent of this request is to secure a waiver of all building permit and related impact fees over which the Board has jurisdiction and thereby help facilitate the recovery of the families and individuals that have already suffered the loss of their homes and other personal property. The anticipated loss in revenue and, therefore, cost to the Department of Building and Safety is estimated at less than \$75,000.
