SUBJECT: Resolution 413-541 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Country Club Drive,
Bermuda Dunes area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-541 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Country Club Drive in the Bermuda Dunes area, as described in attached Resoluion 413-541.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department was contacted by business owners adjacent to Country Club Drive. The concern is that vehicles parking along the curb on certain portions of Country Club Drive restrict sight distance of vehicles exiting nearby driveways.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and met with the business owners. It was determined that a no-stopping zone on Country Club Drive will improve sight distance of motorists exiting driveways and will improve operations and safety on Country Club Drive.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of this No-Stopping Zone.

The Transportation Department has contacted the Indio Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

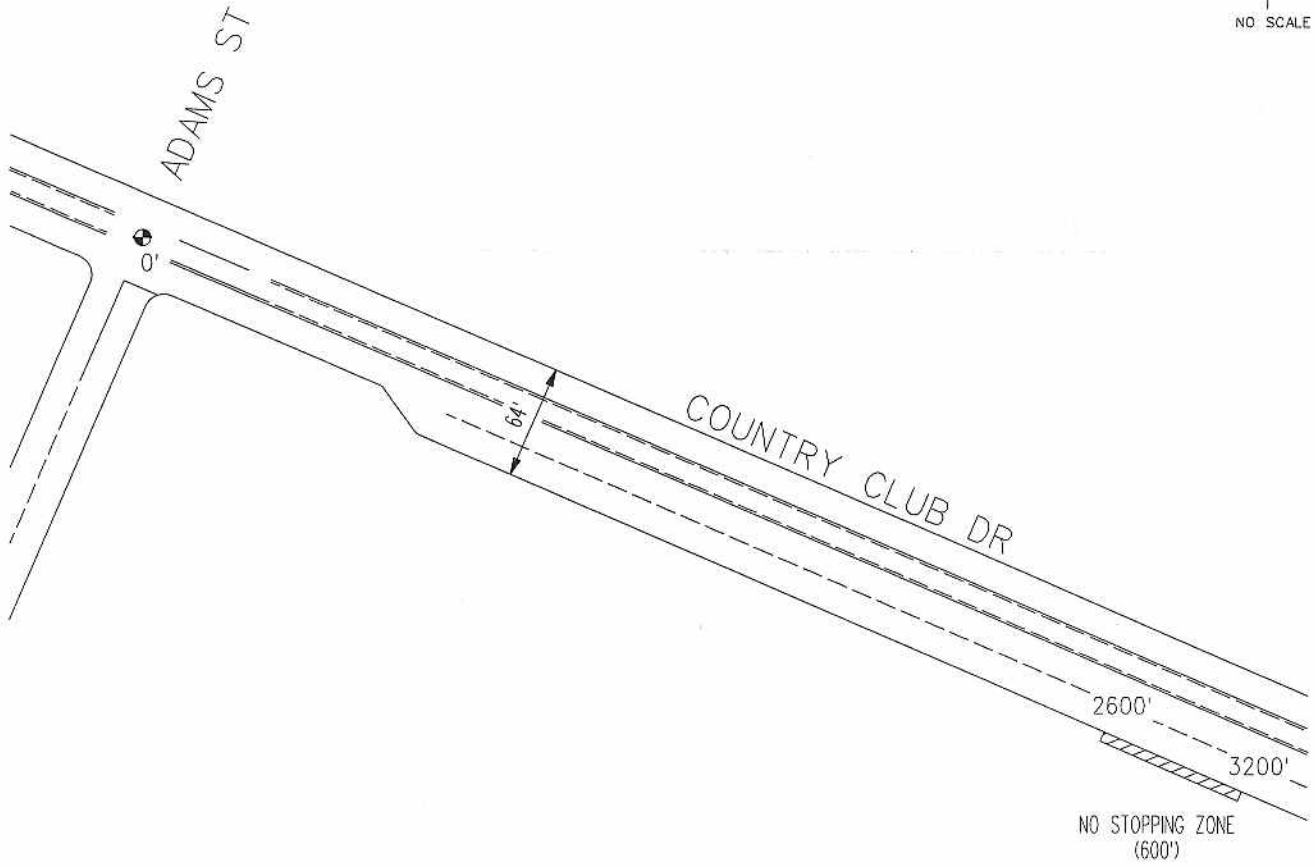
9 On the southwest side of Country Club Drive starting at a point 2,600 feet
