**SUBJECT:** Addition of Three Vehicles to the Sheriff's Fleet

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the acquisition of three additional vehicles for the Sheriff's Training Fleet.

**BACKGROUND:** Over the last year (8/13/02 3.50, 4/15/03 3.25), in a show of support for the Sheriff's Peace Officer Standards Training Perishable Skills-Driver Awareness programs, Nissan of North America has sold the County five vehicles for the token amount of \$1.00 each. Nissan has contacted the Sheriff's Department to offer another three vehicles for the same token amount: a 2004 Infiniti GFX45 VIN JNRBSO-8W73X000021, and two 2003 G35s Sedan VIN JNKCV51E02M000063 JNKCV51E52M000057.

As with the previous vehicles, these vehicles have been used solely for testing and competition and are not equipped to meet state safety and emission control standards. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Sections 4000 and 4000.1, they do not need to be registered because they will not be driven on public roads. The County, in buying these vehicles, must warranty that they will not be used on public roads. The Sheriff's Department will use them solely for training purpose, totally within the Ben Clark Training Center. Vehicle mileage will be minimal, so annual fuel and maintenance costs are estimated at \$800 per car. Student tuition will fund this expense. County Counsel has approved the Bills of Sale as to form.

Note that when the Sheriff's Department takes possession of these vehicles, it will return two Infiniti G20s previously purchased from Nissan. These cars are not equipped with air bags, and therefore, cannot be used for emergency vehicle training.
