**SUBJECT:** Cooperative Agreement for Design and Construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Clinton Street and Palmyra Avenue, Indio area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Approve the Cooperative Agreement by and among the County of Riverside, Desert Sands Unified School District, and the City of Indio for the Design and Construction of a Traffic Signal at the intersection of Clinton Street and Palmyra Avenue, in the Indio area, and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** In cooperation with the Desert Sands Unified School District, the City of Indio and the County of Riverside jointly determined that a school traffic signal is warranted at the intersection of Clinton Street and Palmyra Avenue adjacent to the Lyndon B. Johnson Elementary School.

The proposed traffic signal will improve safety of students crossing Clinton Street and facilitate ingress/egress of school traffic at the intersection.

**BACKGROUND:** (continued)

The City of Indio and the County jointly applied and secured Safe Route 2 School (SR2S) funding for the signal project.

It is recommended that the traffic signal be installed. The City and County will share maintenance costs at 50 percent each, which is estimated at \$2,500 for the County's share. The maintenance cost will be funded by Gas Tax.

The City of Indio and the Desert Sands Unified School District have approved the agreement.

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached agreement and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement.
