**SUBJECT:** Resolution 413-543 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Van Buren Boulevard, Pedley area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board adopt Resolution 413-543 to establish a no-stopping zone on Van Buren Boulevard in the Pedley area, as described in the attached Resolution 413-543.

**BACKGROUND:** At Supervisor Tavaglione's request, the Transportation Department has looked into the matter of the recreational use of the Santa Ana River at Van Buren Boulevard near Clay Street and how it affects traffic patterns/safety at this intersection and on Van Buren Boulevard. Recreational use of the river at this location has become a matter of great concern to public health and safety due to water quality and safety issues on the river.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and determined that parking on the east side of Van Buren Boulevard negatively affects traffic operations and safety by creating additional ingress and egress along Van Buren Boulevard. To prevent the parking, the Transportation Department has installed concrete barriers from the north end of the Santa Ana River Bridge on Van Buren Boulevard northerly to Clay Street. To prevent motorists from parking in the shoulder next to the concrete barrier, a no-stopping zone will be appropriate.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of the No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

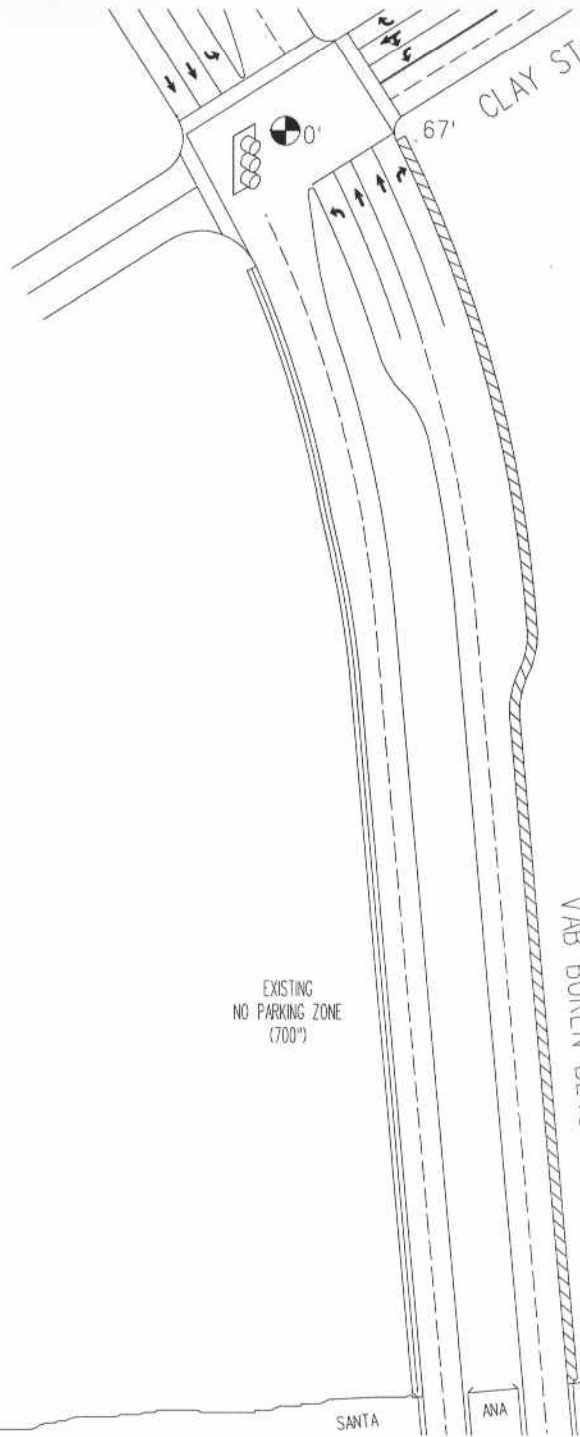
