SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approves and:

1. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Grant Agreement between the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for a Supportive Housing Program (SHP) Grant in the amount of \$543,383 for the period from December 1, 2003 through two years after the start of supportive services; and
2. Authorizes the Director of DPSS to administer the program with Department of Mental Health.

BACKGROUND:

Since 1996, the County of Riverside as part of its County Continuum of Care Consortium, has submitted a consolidated application to HUD on behalf of homeless project sponsors that provide services for homeless persons in Riverside County. As a result of the 2001 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Consolidated Application from the County, HUD has approved Riverside County Department of Mental Health for a Supportive Homeless Intervention Team (HIT) Project, and has executed and provided the attached Grant Agreement to the County for acceptance.

SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH

BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Riverside County Continuum of Care Consortium develops and maintains a seamless system to assist homeless persons and families in Riverside County in achieving self-sufficiency and finding affordable permanent housing. For those not able to achieve self-sufficiency due to illness, age, or infirmity, the Continuum's approach provides a comprehensive foundation for a service delivery system that provides a balance of outreach, prevention, emergency, transitional, and permanent housing with necessary support service resources to move homeless persons and families into the mainstream of society. The Continuum is made up of governmental, non-profit, faith based, and private institutions providing housing, supportive service, outreach, and prevention services to the homeless within the County.

On May 22, 2001 (Agenda Item 3.31), the Board approved a motion to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included a new project submitted by Riverside County Department of Mental Health to provide a supportive housing project. HUD has approved the project and allocated funds shown in the table below.

Department of Mental Health	2 Years	<u>Homeless Intervention Project</u> provides through its Homeless Intervention Team (HIT) outreach, locates homeless mentally disabled persons, conducts assessments and referrals as well as provides emergency and transitional shelter.	\$543,383
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DPSS requests that the Board approves and signs the attached Grant Agreement between DPSS and HUD. The Director of DPSS will later enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Mental Health to run the Homeless Intervention Team Project.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

No County General Funds are required. The budget for the two (2) years is broken down as follows: Year 1 - \$178,947; and Year 2 - \$364,436. The total grant amount is \$543,383.
