**SUBJECT:** Cooperative Agreement for Design and Construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Winchester Road (SR 79) & Willows Avenue/Winchester Creek Road

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Approve the Cooperative Agreement by and between the County of Riverside and the City of Temecula for the Design and Construction of a Traffic Signal at the intersection of Winchester Road (SR 79) & Willows Avenue/Winchester Creek Road, and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** In cooperation with the City of Temecula and Caltrans, it was determined that a traffic signal is warranted at the intersection of Winchester Road (SR 79) & Willows Avenue/Winchester Creek Road.

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety and operations of the intersection, especially for traffic that accesses the residential developments on Willows Avenue and on Winchester Creek Road.

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**BACKGROUND:** (continued)

The total cost of the signal project is estimated at \$331,000. Caltrans is responsible for maintaining SR 79, which represents 50% of the project. The County and City each share one leg or 25% of the intersection. The County has agreed to pay Caltrans portion with the County share being \$248,250 (75%) and the City share being \$82,750 (25%).

It is recommended that the traffic signal be installed. Caltrans will be the responsible agency for maintenance of the signal and pay 50 percent of the maintenance costs. The City and County will share maintenance costs at 25 percent each, which is estimated at \$1,500 for the County's share. The maintenance cost will be funded by Gas Tax.

The City of Temecula has approved the agreement.

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached agreement and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement.
