SUBJECT: Ratify the Contract between the Riverside County Community Health Agency and the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health

BACKGROUND: The California Latino 5 A Day Campaign is a State led initiative by the California Department of Health Services and the Public Health Institute and co-sponsored by the California Department of Education. It is designed to increase the consumption of fruits and vegetables by Latino adults and their families through nutrition education. The Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health, Nutrition Services Branch, as a collaborative partner with the County of San Bernardino, will meet with existing coalitions and collaborative groups in Riverside County to introduce to them the *Latino 5 a Day Campaign* and to identify areas of common ground. Barriers to improving fruit and vegetable consumption and physical activity among Latino adults and their families, will also be identified.

On July 31, 2003, this agreement was received from the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health and preparation of this Form 11 began.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
