SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FRAUD (AIF) PROGRAM GRANT.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program grant award renewal received from the California Department of Insurance.
2. Authorize the District Attorney to sign the standard agreement on behalf of the Board.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Insurance is renewing the grant award agreement for funding the Auto Insurance Fraud Program for the award period from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 in the amount of \$400,000 pursuant to the provisions of section 1872.2 of the California Insurance Code. The grant award is used solely for the purpose of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud and economic car theft cases and shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board. Revenue and appropriations have been included in the FY 2003/04 budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is needed. Board Resolution 2001-355 pertains to this continuing grant and is in effect until June 30, 2004.
