SUBJECT: Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Los Angeles County Regional Criminal Intelligence Center and the Sheriff's Department

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and authorize the Sheriff to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between the Los Angeles County Regional Criminal Intelligence Center (LACRCIC) and the Sheriff's Department outlining the donation of two Clandestine Laboratory Response vehicles to the County.
2. Approve the purchase of two Orion radios from the County Information Technology Department.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County participates in the Office of National Drug Control Policy's High Impact Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) program, which fosters cooperation among law enforcement agencies in their efforts to eliminate drug trafficking locally and nationally. The LA-HIDTA, which is comprised of the Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties, authorizes the use of vehicles purchased by one initiative within the area of another.

The Riverside County Sheriff's Department is a participating agency in the Regional Methamphetamine Task Force (RMTF), funded under LA-HIDTA. During a meeting of RMTF participating agencies, the Sheriff's Department discussed its pressing need to replace its two lab response vehicles. In response, the LACRCIC has used a portion of its HIDTA funds to purchase two 2004 Ford trucks for the Sheriff's Department use in RMTF efforts in Riverside County. The LACRCIC has requested that the County approve a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that defines the County's responsibilities in accepting the vehicles. County Counsel has approved the MOU as to form.

The LACRCIC purchased trucks that meet the specifications developed by the Sheriff's Department for a County Request for Proposals in January 2003. Per the MOU, the County will assume sole ownership of the trucks in three years.

The current fiscal year's cost for these vehicles includes \$7,195 for the purchase and installation of two mobile radios. The Sheriff's Department will absorb all costs for these vehicles within its Patrol budget.
