SUBJECT: Approval of a Personal Service Agreement for Blasting Services for the Transportation Department


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors Approve and Execute the personal service agreement for blasting services for the Transportation Department in the amount of \$112,00 for FY 2003/04.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is ultimately responsible for providing rock and gravel products for various road construction and maintenance projects. These projects consist of extracting base material from the various County-owned gravel pits; screening the material and utilizing the material as road base; and for making asphalt for paving purposes.

The blasting services required are for the Markham pit (located in the Perris area) and the Juniper Flats pit (located in the Homeland area). Both gravel pits have been mined on a continuous basis for several years, and non-rippable rock material has been encountered, which requires blasting in order for gravel mining operations to continue.

The Transportation Department issued a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) for these services. Solicitations were sent to eight vendors and advertised on the Internet. Two (2) responses were
