SUBJECT: Approval of Agreement between the Department of Public Social Services-Department of Community Action and Perris Valley Youth Association Sports

BACKGROUND:

DPSS-DCA is the official anti-poverty agency for the County of Riverside. It works with and through a network of community and faith-based organizations along with public and private sector organizations to provide a number of high impact social and economic strategies that empower family self-sufficiency. The funding source for many of these programs is the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) that funds programs which benefit people living at or below the poverty level in Riverside County. All proposed programs must focus on moving families out of poverty and build on existing community resources and assets.

One of the CSBG Funding Initiatives is the Youth: Mandatory Mentoring Component. The DPSS-DCA Commission has identified the community of Perris as a high poverty pocket and therefore has targeted this area for a Youth Initiative. A funding opportunity was made available to the Perris Community with the release of a Letter of Interest (LOI) publicized on October 22, 2003 in a newspaper in the Perris area. Only one response was received as a result of this LOI.

Perris Valley Youth Association Sports is requesting funding to cover the \$150 registration fee for 166 youth to participate in the Perris Valley Pop Warner Football League/Cheerleading Squad. Youth will receive recreational mentoring from adult athletic coaches in physical fitness, discipline, focus, sportsmanship, teamwork and social skills. Adult team leaders will mentor youth in civic responsibility and engage youth in community volunteer service activities. The season started July 1, 2003 and will end December 31, 2003. They are requesting a grant in the amount of \$25,000.
