SUBJECT: Agreement with University of California (UCLA) for the Research Study Agreement for Treatment System Impact and Outcomes of Proposition 36 (TSI).

BACKGROUND (CONT'D)

This study is funded by the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) and has been approved by the Institutional Review Boards at UCLA and the California Health and Human Services Agency, Committee for the Protection of Human Subjects.

Riverside County Department of Mental Health (DOMH) is one of forty (40) programs in five counties who were invited to participate. The Riverside County Substance Abuse Program located at 1827 Atlanta Ave, Ste. D-1 will be the designated program to facilitate this research study. Under this research agreement, the DOMH will facilitate the data collection and contact with Proposition 36 clients entering treatment after November 1, 2003.

DOMH RESPONSIBILITES

DOMH will communicate with UCLA regularly by:

- Maintaining regular communication with UCLA via telephone, email, and meetings.
- Assisting UCLA in tracking and locating Proposition 36 clients for follow-up interviews.
- Attending UCLA sponsored TSI meetings
- Appointing a coordinator who will act as the primary liaison between UCLA and the program.

REIMBURSEMENT AND PAYMENT

For a pre-determined number of Proposition 36 clients, UCLA will provide \$40.00 to \$50.00 per Prop 36 client who has a completed set of data. The total amount of the agreement shall not exceed \$3,780 subject to the availability of funding.

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance for this agreement is November 1, 2003 through November 1, 2005 unless an extended period of performance is negotiated between DOMH and UCLA. This agreement is subject to the availability of funds.
