**SUBJECT:** APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NUMBER 2003-10 AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR THE RIVER PARKWAYS PROGRAM UNDER THE CALIFORNIA CLEAN WATER, CLEAN AIR, SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS, AND COASTAL PROTECTION ACT OF 2002 (PROPOSITION 40)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Directors approve Resolution No. 2003-10 authorizing the Regional Park and Open-Space District to apply for and expend grant funds under the Proposition 40 River Parkways program for planning and development of the Santa Ana River Multi-Purpose Trail.

**BACKGROUND:** Under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 ("Proposition 40"), the State of California Resources Agency has allocated \$10 million to the counties of Riverside, San Bernardino, and Orange for work related to the development of the Santa Ana River Trail project. The \$10 million is to be split equally among the three counties, and no local matching funds are required.

Subject: APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NUMBER 2003-10 AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR THE RIVER PARKWAYS PROGRAM UNDER THE CALIFORNIA CLEAN WATER, CLEAN AIR, SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS, AND COASTAL PROTECTION ACT OF 2002 (PROPOSITION 40)

As the administrator of the Proposition 40 River Parkways program, the State of California Resources Agency issued a Grant Guide that set forth administrative procedures and requirements for the River Parkways program. The Grant Guide requires the submission of signed resolutions by the governing bodies of local park and recreation agencies authorizing eligible applicants to apply for and expend Proposition 40 River Parkways grant funds. Those authorizing resolutions must be submitted to the Resources Agency, which then issues individual grant contracts for the River Parkways program. Grant funding for all individual Proposition 40 projects is based upon the execution of those contracts and the subsequent submission and approval of individual Project Application Forms.

Attached is Resolution Number 2003-10, which must be submitted to the Resources Agency by the Park District in order to establish eligibility for Proposition 40 River Parkways grant funding.

By means of Minute Order 13.3, 11/25/03, your Board recently approved a list of capital improvement projects to be funded by Proposition 40 Per Capita and Roberti-Z'berg program grants. Since the Santa Ana River trail project will be financed from a different source of Proposition 40 funding, it is an addition to that project list. The Santa Ana River Multi-purpose Trail is included in the Park District's Capital Improvement Program at a total cost of \$5,536,774; project funding will be derived from a combination of State grants (Proposition 12 and Proposition 40) and Development Impact Fees collected for multi-purpose trail purposes.
