**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached Professional Service Agreements with Michael Y. Corbett; Bill Duplissee; John Quimby; Robert Presley and Nielsen, Merksamer, Parinello, Mueller and Naylor (James C. Gross, Managing Partner) for State Legislative Advocacy Services.

**BACKGROUND:** On December 2, 2003, the Board authorized the Executive Office to enter into contract negotiations with the five individuals named above for State Legislative Advocacy Services as part of the proposed bipartisan state lobbying team. On December 10, 2003, the Chairman of the Board, the County Executive Officer, and the Legislative Manager met with the proposed team to establish priorities and discuss major legislative issues. Michael Corbett will be the primary liaison between the team and County officials and will serve as the County's Sacramento based Legislative Coordinator. The proposed contracts are for one year: January 1, 2004 to December 31, 2004. At the discretion of the Board, each contract can be extended for two additional years under the same terms.
