**SUBJECT:** Ratify the First Amendment to Renewal Agreement, with Volunteer Center of Riverside County, FY 2003/04 for Ombudsman services for Riverside County.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached First Amendment to renewal agreement with Volunteer Center of Riverside County.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the First Amendment.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

**BACKGROUND:** The First Amendment to Renewal agreement with Volunteer Center of Riverside County covering the period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in the reimbursable amount of \$373,768 reflects an Ombudsman Initiative increase of \$110,645 and \$8,174 increase funding for Facilities Visits.

The Ombudsman Initiative or Governor's Long Term Care Consumer Protection Initiative increases protections for residents of California's long term care facilities by the augmentation of new Ombudsmen at Skilled Nursing Facilities by 50% in three years, additionally having appearance at Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly and by increasing fines for citations issued to nursing homes.

**BACKGROUND:** (continued)
